**Lorton Village Shop** [www.lortonvillageshop.co.uk](http://www.lortonvillageshop.co.uk)

Opening times: Monday to Saturday 9am – 5pm Sunday - closed

There are local food shops in **Cockermouth**. There are two butchers, one in Station Street, one in Main Street. There is a greengrocers and a fish shop in Station Street. Brysons, the bakers, is on Main Street and Coffee Kitchen Bakery is in Market Place. There is a Sainsbury's supermarket: opening times are: Monday to Saturday 8am – 9pm Sunday, 11am to 5pm.

If you drive into the centre on the Lorton Road you will see it ahead: turn left and then right at the mini – roundabout to get into Fairfield carpark.

Car park charges are:

Up to 1 hour - £1.30

1 hr to 1½ hr - £2.20

Up to 2 hour - £2.60

After 7 pm - £1.00

Sainsburys will refund £1.30 for £10 shop.

On road parking is by disc display; there should be a disc in the cottage but they are also readily available in the shops.
